## Clever, thoughtful design...

We re-commissioned Tom Ground, one of the region's foremost architects in care home design, as well as using our combined experience in creating this unique new development.

Consequently, much thought and planning has gone into the design, layout and facilities that are available at Dell House:

- A central hub with welcoming reception, Hester's Café, access to the terrace and gardens, Revive Salon and The Southwold Day Room. There's plenty of seating in the hub and it's a lovely spot to sit and watch people go by.
- Four beautifully individual dining rooms, promoting small-group living, make meal times a relaxing, but important, element of the day. With a carefully chosen menu, together with a sherry before lunch or perhaps a glass of wine with your meal, what could be better?
- The home is separated into different areas, allowing small-group living with people of a similar disposition, with all bedrooms and communal rooms having large windows to let in lots of natural light. Cosy lounges with wood-burning-effect fireplaces complete the homely feel.
- A purpose-designed cinema the perfect venue to create an atmosphere whilst watching a classic film, Wimbledon or even Royal pageantry!

## The importance of gardens...

A central theme of Dell House is the residents' access and proximity to the gardens. The building has been designed so that residents will feel connected to the tranquillity of the outdoors, as well as having the constant reminder of the ever-changing seasons.

All ground-floor rooms have access to their own little terrace, with first-floor bedrooms having large windows either looking out to the wonderful farreaching views of the Waveney Valley or to the school playing fields to the south. The first floor also has two outside terraces, ideal for enjoying that mid-morning cup of coffee while taking in the views.

The home also benefits from a lovely south-facing terrace as well as a path that meanders under the trees to the gazebo.







Our head office, Pen House, is situated in Earsham, near Bungay, only half an hour's drive from any one of our four homes. Here, we have a team of people whose job it is to support the management teams at each of our homes, ensuring that nothing is run at 'arm's length':

Marina, our Training Manager, delivers our excellent induction and ongoing training sessions in our purpose-made training room;


John, our Maintenance Manager, ensures all the homes our well-maintained, with a real focus on health and safety;
